

DLSC, Budgam settles 8 cases DC for expeditious processing of all the pending cases

The District Level Screening Committee, Budgam, in its meeting convened under the Chairmanship of District Development Commissioner, Mir Altaf Ahmad, has settled 8 cases of different categories. These include 3 cases for cash assistance of Rs 4 lakhs each in favour of the next of kin (NOK) in lieu of employment/ appointment, whereas 2 cases were cleared for Govt. Job under SRO 43. The meeting also cleared a case for regularization of his services in the Agriculture Department, Budgam. Two cases were cleared for grant of Rs. One lakh as ex-gratia relief to each under the category of missing persons and death. The meeting was attended by the SSP, Budgam, Adl Deputy Commissioner, Army officers and Chief Agriculture Officer Budgam. Speaking on the occasion, District Development Commissioner enjoined the concerned officers to process all the pending cases on account of SRO 43, Death in Harness and militancy related matters as early so that the bereaved families get relief without any difficulty. While urging the officers to be responsive to the grievances of the people, the District Development commissioner said service to humanity is the best form of worship. He said the people especially poorest of the poor have pinned high hopes with the administration adding that onus lies with the ground level officers and field functionaries to come upto their expectations and aspirations. He said that functioning of each office and department in the district is being regularly monitored and the best performing officers and employees will be rewarded suitably.
