

DDC Budgam Suspended Two Medical Officers at Pakherpora

DC Budgam suspends two medical officers of SDH, Pakherpora for dereliction of duty, Appoints SDM, Chadoora as inquiry officer into Pakherpora Bus accident Budgam, November 10,2015:- Taking serious note of the absence of doctors on duty at Sub District Hospital, Pakherpora on 8th November , the day when a passenger vehicle met an accident near Pakherpora, causing alleged delay in the emergency medical treatment to the injured passengers, the District Development Commissioner Budgam, Mir Altaf Ahmad today placed under suspension Two Medical officers, Dr.Umer- bin-Hassan and Dr. Shabir Ahmad pending inquiry ordered into the matter. The Sub Divisional Magistrate, Chadoora has been nominated as the inquiry hospital, who will submit his report within fifteen days along with his recommendations. Worthwhile to mention, one lady died on spot and several other passengers got severely injured in the accident, who had to be sent to Srinagar for treatment due to absence of these doctors scheduled on duty at the SDH, Pakherpora the fateful day. Meanwhile, the District Development Commissioner Budgam has asked all the Medical and Para- Medical staff to attend their assigned duties at their respective health institutions punctually with social commitment adding that no laxity will be tolerated on this account. He has also directed officers and employees of all other departments functioning in the district to be present at their respective places of duty during office hours to attend to the public grievances adding that dereliction of duty will be viewed seriously. The DDC has warned that mobile checking squads have been constituted at District and Block levels in the district to monitor functioning in various offices and attendance of employees especially during the ongoing winters when people are confronted with more problems.
