## DDC Budgam reviews post snow preparedness

The DDC Budgam today reviewed post snow preparedness at a joint meeting of the officers of district administers and Engineers .He asked the R&B, Mechanical, PMGSY departments to divide in between road lengths in different area s of the district for snow clearance operations so that a smooth and hassle free mechanism is put in place for this purpose. He said snow clearance from Lanes and Drains should be left for Municipal Committees. It was decided that the mechanical department shall remove from 846 kms of road length, R&B from about 700Kms and PMGS from the remaining 28 kms. He called for setting up of a centralized Control room to coordinate snow clearance and road opening activities in case of exigencies. He asked for keeping maximum number of snow clearance machines in a state of readyness at important sites. While viewing the winter stocking of food grains in the district, the Asst. Director informed that 36000qts of rice, 2980qts of Atta and 3500 gas cylinders are available for distribution among the consumers besides a stock of 2.10 lakh Qtl of ration in the FCI godowns. The DDC asked the CMO Budgam to ensure punctuality of medical and paramedical staff in heath centers. He asked the engineers of PDD to provide power supply to the consumers strictly as per curtailment schedule and ensure that power transmission lines do not get disrupted due to snowing.
