



Public Durbar convened at DIET Beerwah

BUDGAM, FEBRUARY 6: A public durbar was held 6 February at DIET Beerwah to get first hand appraisal of public issues and grievances.

District Development Commissioner Budgam , Mr.Mir Altaf Ahmed conducted the darbar and took stock of the problems of the people living in the area, during which officials of Police, R&B, PDD, PMGSY, PHE, I&FC, and other concerned Departments, besides, members of civil society of the area also participated.

During the darbar, locals raised issues like repair of roads, water supply, proper medicare, working of Anganwari centre, ration supply, power, veterinary facility for cattle, and other related issues.

The DDC assured them that their genuine demands would be looked into and fulfilled at the earliest and informed the locals about various welfare and development programmes of the Government for the area.

Resolving various grievances on the spot, the DDC directed the Tehsildar Beerwah to demarcate the area for Bus Stand within ten days. He also directed the Executive Officer of Municipal Committee to set up latrine complex in the bus stand including a separate one for ladies. The PDD authorities were directed to undertake repair of damaged poles and replace barbed wires at the earliest for which necessary allotment has already been made. He also directed the PHE authorities to submit the DPR for Aripanthan Water Supply at the earliest and R&B officials were directed to start work on Budgam-Beerwah road at the earliest.

Interacting with the locals, SSP Budgam sought their active cooperation in eradication of various social evils such as gambling, drug addiction etc and to ensure peace prevails in the area.
