



DDC Budgam reviews Education Scenario.

Budgam, 5th February 2017: DDC Budgam, Mr.Mir Altaf Ahmad today convened a meeting to review the Education Scenario in the district. Among others the meeting was attended by CEO Budgam and various ZEOs.

It was informed that CMs Super 50 initiative is functioning satisfactorily in the district. Taking a stock of initiatives in the district, it was informed that 12000 students are enrolled under winter tuition program where 853 teachers are providing necessary guidance to students from middle to 12th class. Further it was informed that under Winter Camp initiative 2700 students from class 3rd to 7th class are being provided necessary guidance by 26 teachers.

Taking stock of damages to infrastructure of educational institutes due to snowfall, the DDC directed the concerned to ensure that the repair work is completed within 15 days so that students don't have to face any inconvenience in the upcoming session.

The DDC also directed the ZEOs to identify suitable centers which would be equipped with requisite paraphernalia and AADHAR enrolment will be started at such centers for the convenience of students.

Further the DDC directed the CEO to ensure that private tuitions /coaching centers functioning in the district comply with the rules/orders in vogue. It was informed by CEO that 12 teachers including 6 gazette teachers have been suspended in this regard. The DDC also directed the concerned ZEOs not to leave the station without the permission of competent authorities.

Meanwhile DDC Budgam also conducted a visit to Sheikhpura where Tehsildar was directed to accommodate certain inhabitants, who feared damage to their shelters due to landslip, in Panchayat Ghar.
