



### **D.C Budgam reviews arrangements for exams.**

BUDGAM, NOVEMBER 11: In the backdrop of BOSE Examinations scheduled to be held from November 14, DC Budgam, Mir Altaf Ahmad, today chaired a meeting to review the arrangements put in place.

SSP Budgam, Examination Superintendents, Observers and Officers vested with magisterial powers attended the meeting.

The meeting was informed that in the district of Budgam, 3300 students will write the Class X<sup>th</sup> Exam while as 5700 students would write Class XII<sup>th</sup> exam at 123 designated examination centres. It was also informed that 765 staff members, 21 observers and 65 magisterial officers have been deployed for smooth conduct of examination. Further it was decided to deploy two Anganwadi Workers at each centre for the purpose of frisking female students.

While reviewing the security measures, DC Budgam informed that prohibitory restrictions under Section 144 under Cr.PC shall be imposed within the radius of 200 meters of all the exam centres to check outside interference. However, the supervisory staff and checking squad associated with the examination, besides students would be exempted from the operation of this magisterial order.

DC Budgam impressed upon the concerned authorities to implement the instructions in letter and spirit and to ensure that all requisite facilities are put in place for smooth conduct of examination. Further they were urged to ensure coordination with police authorities and officers with magisterial powers so that there is no slackness.
