



## **DDC Budgam reviews developmental scenario.**

BUDGAM, FEBRUARY 08: District Development Commissioner Budgam, Mr. Mir Altaf Ahmad, today chaired a meeting to take a comprehensive review of various developmental projects being executed under various sectors in the district and exhorted upon the concerned officers to ensure time bound completion of these works upon the officers to redouble their efforts for achieving the physical as well as financial targets and to formulate a contingency plan for works to be executed in double shifts.

Officers of the district administration, engineers from various engineering wings and other concerned attended the meeting.

On the occasion, the District Development Commissioner stressed The meeting was informed that up to ending January 2017 out of the total available funds 80.3% percent stands expended. It was further said that under PMGSY, 13 schemes have been sanctioned and F.W Stage 1 of 113.29 kms and under B.T Stage have been completed at a cost of Rs 65 crores.

The DDC also reviewed progress under various Centrally Sponsored Schemes like MGNREGA, IAY, NHM, RMSA, SSA, Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana and various other schemes of Power Development Department, PHE , PMGSY and others.DDC also directed ACD to ensure timely completion of the works taken up under convergence with MGNREGA in Youth, Services and Sports and Education sector for creating better infrastructure. While reviewing schemes under PDD, particularly implementation of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana, the District Development Commissioner stressed on timely completion of projects taken up under PHE and Irrigation & Flood Control sectors. The District Development Commissioner asked the Youth and Sports Department to organize sports events to exploit the potential of youth.

He also reviewed in depth the functioning of Doodhpatri and Yousmarg Development Authorities under Swadesh Darshan Scheme.

The DDC also took a profound review of the CM's commitments during her various visits to the district. In depth deliberations were also held on various decisions taken in District Development Board meeting.
