

## District Development Commissioner Budgam reviews pace of developmental projects:



BUDGAM, November 03: District Development Commissioner Budgam, Mir Altaf Ahmad today took a comprehensive review of various developmental projects being executed under various sectors in Budgam including other State Sector/CSS Schemes at a high level meeting of officers of district administration and engineers from various engineering wings here.

At the outset, it was informed that up to ending October, 2016 out of the available funds 63 per cent stands expended.

Appreciating the efforts made for providing services to the people by the Health, PHE, PDD, Urban Development and Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department during the prevailing situation, the District Development Commissioner stressed upon the various departments particularly Engineering departments to redouble their efforts for achieving the targets and to formulate a contingency plan for works to be executed in double shifts and to ensure that people do not face any inconvenience in the coming winters.

The meeting was informed that under R&B Sector, 33.8 kms road length has been macadamized. The meeting was informed that 16 schemes are under progress.

Discussing issues pertaining to PDD particularly implementation of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana, the DDC stressed on timely completion of projects taken up under PHE and Irrigation & Flood Control sectors. He also reviewed pace of work undertaken under Rural Development Department.

Reviewing the working of ICDS, the DDC directed to expedite the tendering process and ensure procurement of quality and standard nutrition items. He also directed the forest authorities to ensure that no miscreant take advantage of the present situation and indulge in smuggling or felling of green trees.

The DDC while taking an in depth review of Education Department also reviewed the progress under various schemes such as RMSA, SSA and Midday Meal.

The District Development Commissioner asked the Youth and Sports Department to organize sports events to exploit the potential of youth. The District Development Commissioner also reviewed the functioning of Doodhpatri and Yousmarg Development Authorities. An in-depth review of Cooperatives, Fisheries, Sericulture, Animal and Sheep Husbandry, Agriculture Production and Social Welfare department was also taken.

The DDC also discussed issues pertaining to Board Decision and CM's commitments.
